Item 1–New Club Approvals:

Note: Each of the clubs listed have been "provisionally approved" per our bylaws, Article II-A-1. Per Article III-9, where provisionally approved clubs are considered for full affiliation, "this item shall be accorded priority in the order of business." If you have any questions regarding our requirements for club affiliation, please see Article II-A of the bylaws.
